Sub: APRA-2014- Employee bifurcation in Telangana power utilities-Request for kind justice in the matter-reg

Ref: MoH letter ref No. F.No.120/12/2014—SR dated nil in July-2015.

Telangana Electricity Engineers Association is highly thankful for the courtesy extended to our office bearers during their visit to your office on 6<sup>th</sup> instant regarding the captioned subject.

We are also thankful for your assurances of providing equal justice while taking any decision by MoH with regard to bifurcation of employees in power sector utilities in Telangana and AP.

In this regard we inform that a letter dated nil cited under reference is received from the Ministry of Home Affairs addressed to both states chief secretaries (received on 24<sup>th</sup> July-2015) acting based on the Chief Secretary of AP letter dated 09-06-2015 without any deliberations from Telangana state which has unnecessarily fuelled the employees working in Telangana power sector.

We further feel that the time of the above letter is also unwarranted when there is a scheduled meeting on  $31^{\rm st}$  instant with chief secretaries, Energy secretaries and Chairman and managing directors of both TSTRANSCO and APTRANSCO on the captioned subject.

Vide above letter it is also suggested by MoH that both the boards to decide the modalities on the principles' of Kamalanathan Committee.

In this connection we submit that vide combined circular Memo No.19184/SR/A1//2014 dated 5-11-2014 signed by both states chief secretaries have clarified that the public sector undertaking and Government Institutions scheduled in IX and X are excluded from the ambit of Kamalanathan Committee guidelines.

The above advisory committee also in their 9<sup>th</sup> meeting vide SNo.8 has clarified that "As the position stands the committee has no jurisdiction except the allotment of government servants working in these institutions". The committee also clarified to our association number of times that the employee bifurcation in PSU and Government Institutions is not in their purview.

Further the internal committee of TS Power Utilities has not acted unilaterally as said by AP. The committee has formulated the guide lines without any bias as per the provisions of section-82 of APRA-2014 duly informing the APTRANSCO time to time in a most democratic way duly providing the opportunity to all the affected employees to raise their objections and by placing the employee data in the public domain.

The criteria followed in the employee bifurcations is that for the period where employees have been recruited without following the spirit of 371D article i.e. during the 1975-2009 on the nativity basis as recorded in the appointment order, initial service record and police antecedents and for the employees recruited after year-2009 are being allotted as per the provisions of above article duly providing the justice to all.

It is our submission not to mandate the Kamalanathan Committee on the power sector employee bifurcation process as this committee has not made any study on the prevailing service conditions in the public sector undertakings and not made any deliberation with employee associations of PSU and Government institutions.

As such we request your kind intervention to provide the justice duly causing necessary instructions to AP Power utilities to take all the relieved engineers from TS Power Utilities and to relieve all the Telangana employees working in AP Power utilities to resolve the issue once for all.

Thanking you and your instruction in the matter is highly solicited to provide the justice to the Telangana employees who have been deprived of their rights since decades.
